Fridays: 10 - 5 **Sundays:** Closed

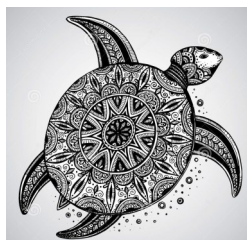

August 16 at 6 pm

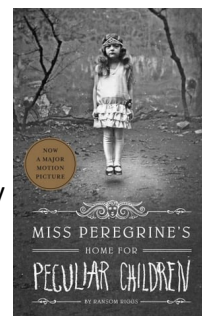
