For adults of all skill levels—multiple games featured!

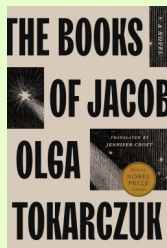
Tech Time: Tuesdays at 2 pm

Fall Community Book Club: September 4 at 5 pm in Prologue Books and Wine

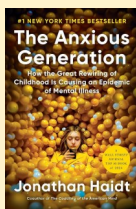

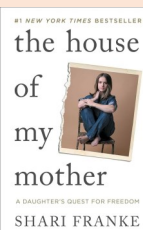


Diamond Art Night:

Back for the fall! September's theme will be magazines — find a recipe in a library magazine, provide a copy to the library, and make it to share with others at our meeting!



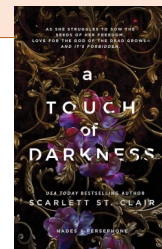
True Crime Book Club:
