**Tech Time:** Tuesdays at 2 pm



## **Fall Community Book Club**: September 4 at 5 pm in Prologue Books and Wine






Folks are invited to join us for four evening book discussions this fall! This session's inaugural book is *The Art Thief* by Michael Finkel on September 4, and

### **Romantasy Readers Book Club:**


