Beat the Blues Programming




Need a break from the Iowa winter? Check out our featured programming designed to help keep us happy and healthy - with no sign-up required - beginning January 12! This includes:

January 6 at 10 am




For adults of all skill levels.

Diamond Art Night: January 20 at 6:30 pm




Come, socialize, and create diamond art! All skill levels welcome.

Cookbook Club: January 22 at 6:30 pm





January's theme will be Bowls - if it requires a bowl for eating or preparation, it's fair game! Find a recipe in a library cookbook and make it to share with others at our meeting.
