A message from Library Director, Annette Dean:

It's always a great time to get involved at the Library:

1. Volunteer: Help with shelving, events, or special projects.
2. Join Friends of the Library: Support through fundraising and advocacy. Friends of the Library is always looking for library lovers to join the friends' board. The board meets 4 times a year and supports library programming and reading programs in the community.
3. Attend Events: The library uses attendance to determine the success of a program or community interest in a particular topic. Attendance numbers are also used to justify funding of special programs, so its important that individuals attend programs that interest them.
4. Donate: The library has two non-profit 501(c)(3) organizations that help supplement the city and county taxes that fund it. The Friends of the Library provide support to programming and special projects that benefit the community and library (such as the Storywalk). The library foundation supports the library collection by providing funds to purchase almost half of the book collection.
5. Advocate: Promote library services in the community. I've lost track of how many times I have heard the phrase "The library has that!?" Is there a service or program that you love? Tell a friend, you will be surprised at how fast information spreads by word of mouth and many people will be surprised by what there is to do at the library.
